

## ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

### **College Way (SR-538) (at railroad tracks)**

**December 12-14, 2012**

The City of Mount Vernon has been working with Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) and the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for many months to improve the railroad crossing at College Way. BNSF has indicated the need for a "full panel removal" which involves cutting the rail, replacing rails and ties, and repaving.

Beginning Wednesday, December 12, 2012, College Way will be closed to all traffic at the railroad tracks for a period of 48 hours. Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) will be making critical repairs to the railroad crossing. Repairs are expected to begin at 9:00 am on Wednesday, and College Way is anticipated to reopen to traffic by 9:00 am Friday, December 14, 2012.

Westbound traffic will be detoured at Continental to Hoag then onto Urban back to College Way.

Eastbound traffic will be detoured at Urban to Hoag then onto Continental back to College Way.

While flaggers will be used to improve the flow of traffic during congested hours, delays are to be expected. Motorists are urged to use alternate routes.
