

Press Release: Bank Robbery Investigation

On September 9, 2016 at approximately 11:48am, a white male entered Key Bank located at 212 E. College Way, Mount Vernon, approached a teller and demanded money. No weapon was used and no one was injured during the incident. The male suspect left the bank with an undetermined amount of money, last seen walking through the parking lot southeast from the bank.

Patrol officers were quick to respond checking area parking lots and adjacent businesses, but did not locate the suspect.

The bank was temporarily closed while investigators processed the scene. The Federal Bureau of Investigations is assisting investigators, as the bank is federally insured.

Suspect Description:

White, Male 20-25 years old, short dark brown hair

6' 0", slender build

Wearing: jeans, brown/tan plaid button shirt, black zipper jacket, glasses and white/neon green running shoes
