On November 16, 2016 at approximately 0300 hours, Mount Vernon Police arrested 23-year old Enrique Manzo of Mount Vernon on charges of Robbery, Kidnapping and Assault in reference to this case.

Detectives had been following up on numerous leads, and recently received information from the Washington State Crime Lab, identifying Enrique Manzo's fingerprints on evidence found inside the victim's vehicle. Additionally, Detectives conducted a search warrant on a vehicle associated to Manzo at the time of his arrest, locating additional items of evidence linking Manzo to this case.

Manzo is currently being held at the Skagit County Jail on charges of Robbery 1st, Kidnapping 1st and Assault 2nd.

Original Press Release

On October 17, 2016 at approximately 5:40am, the victim was exiting the Chevron mini-mart, located at 2200 E. College Way, and was contacted by the suspect who asked for a ride. The victim agreed to assist and while driving toward I-5 on College Way, the suspect pulled out a handgun, pointed it at the victim and demanded all his money.

The suspect then ordered the victim to take him to several locations in Mount Vernon, after which he let the victim out of the vehicle. The suspect then left in the victim's vehicle, which was later recovered in the 1800 block of East College Way.

Light-skinned Hispanic male, spoke in Spanish

Late 20's

Approximately 5' 4"

Wearing a black hoody or jacket with a white logo on the upper left chest
