Mount Vernon resident cardholders* can now apply for free library cards at all the libraries in Skagit County in 3 easy steps:

- 1) Be sure your MVCL card is current. Stop by our circulation desk to update your card and obtain this year's sticker.
- 2) Bring your MVCL card, photo ID, and proof of current residence to any of the participating libraries.
- 3) Every year, you will be asked to verify your residence and contact information and will receive a new sticker on your MVCL card indicating it is current.

Please remember that each library has its own policies. Materials must be returned to the library from which they were borrowed.



*Resident cardholders are those who do not pay an additional fee for a card at MVCL. Ask at the Front Desk to see if you qualify for the Reciprocal Program.
