It is broadcast in Mount Vernon on Comcast channels 10 and 26. Text is displayed throughout the day, seven days a week, during all non-program (taped or live) playback hours.

Guidelines

- All bulletins must be submitted on this form. General press releases will not be considered.
- Forms must be submitted at least seven working days prior to the first requested display date. Forms may be brought in, submitted online or through the mail.
- When you submit this form you may choose to provide the station with a copy of your agency logo and/or with any images for which you own the copyright. We also encourage you to include any pre-existing materials (ex. flyers, posters, etc.) that are being used to announce your event.
- No information shall be transmitted which involves advertising on behalf of candidates for public office or political issues, lottery information, or obscene/indecent matter.
- In order to maximize use of the Community Bulletin Board for messages of broad public interest, regular community group and church service schedules will not be announced.
- The City Television Advisory Committee reserves the right to edit and to reject messages. As appropriate, appeals to the decision of the City Television Advisory Committee may be made to the Mayor.
