Single family residence, owner occupied duplex, tri-plex and four-plex customers **that are located within the Mount Vernon City Limits** can dispose one average load each (three separate loads) of garbage, recycling and yard waste at the City of Mount Vernon Shop Complex

FREE OF CHARGE!

Location: City Of Mount Vernon Shop Complex 1010 Shop Lane

If your garbage day is on Tuesday , Wednesday or Friday your clean-up day will be April 10th from 9am-4pm.

If your garbage day is on Monday or Thursday your clean-up day will be April 17th from 9am-4pm.

****If you are unable to attend the clean-up on your assigned day, you may bring your loads on the opposite day****

2021 Spring Clean-up

All residents within the City Limits MUST present their March or April City of Mount Vernon utility bill and a valid ID verifying City of Mount Vernon address to dispose of one load of garbage, recycling and yard waste.

NO OTHER UTILITY BILL WILL BE ACCEPTED

Only one load of each- Please separate each load as mixed loads will not be accepted

- **All trash must be bagged.**
- **No loose garbage loads will be accepted.**
- **City of Mount Vernon Solid Waste staff has the right to refuse loads that are not bagged.**
- **All resident are required to wear a mask and remain inside your vehicle**
- **Residents must present a physical copy of March or April City of Mount Vernon utility bill**

No commercial loads will be accepted!

No U-Haul vans or extremely large trailers will be accepted!

2021 Spring Clean-up

We will accept the following items:

Household garbage

Junk & debris

Furniture items (couch's, chairs, tables, mattresses, etc.)

Clean wood (2x4's, 4x4's, plywood, decks, fences, etc.)

Recycle materials (cardboard, mixed paper, tin, glass, and aluminum cans)

Scrap Metal (stoves, washers, dryers, barbecues, lawn mowers, hot water tanks, etc.)

Please remove gas and oil from engine)

Yard Waste (grass, leaves, brush, branches etc.)

5 gallons maximum of household paint

5 pounds maximum of alkaline household batteries

We **CANNOT** accept the following items, but we can offer contact information regarding their proper disposal:
