


## Fireworks in the City of Mount Vernon


Thank you for taking the time to provide feedback, as city council considers the current restrictions around fireworks.


1. Are you a resident of Mount Vernon, residing within city limits?




2. As a part of my household 4th of July activities, I typically engage in the following activities (click all that apply)...




3. How important is the personal use of fireworks to you and your family on the 4th of July?
