



The first rule to consider for environmental stewardship is **Reduce - Reuse - Recycle**. Finishes like the polished concrete floor utilize a structural element as the finish without a need to add another finish over the top.

When materials were chosen for the Mount Vernon Library Commons, they were selected based on their recycled content as well as their ability to be recycled at the end of their life.

Shown here are just a few products that were specified to have recycled content.

- Up to 20% post-consumer products



Steel Decking

- Approximately 60% pre- and post-consumer



Concrete Reinforcing (Rebar)

- Approximately 60% pre- and post-consumer
