



One way to reduce the environmental impacts of a project is to use products that are manufactured close to the site to reduce the transportation impacts.

As many products as could be specified from local suppliers were included, although as a public bid project, they could not be guaranteed (sole-sourcing of materials is not allowed in public bidding as it may not be fair to competitors).

The following products and materials are sourced from within 500 miles of the project, which is the sustainability benchmark for "regional".


