

RESOLUTION NO. 1070

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MOUNT VERNON, WASHINGTON COUNCIL; FORMING A CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE CONSISTENT WITH RESOLUTION 491, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING INPUT ON THE CITY'S 2025 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, on March 10, 1999 the City adopted Resolution 491, a Public Participation Program pursuant to the State Growth Management Act, in response to an order of the Western Washington Growth Management Hearing Board (Cause No. 98-2-0006c); and

WHEREAS, the Public Participation Program adopted via Resolution 491, among other things, includes the process by which Citizen Advisory Committees can be established by the City; and

WHEREAS, due to the public input that is required as part of the City's 2025 Comprehensive Plan Update the Development Services Department is requesting that a Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) be established; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has compiled a list of stakeholders and completed recruitment per Resolution 1062 (**Exhibit A**);

WHEREAS, the City Council deliberated and formed the CAC from the applicants listed in **Exhibit A**.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT VERNON:
