

Comprehensive Planning Resources

A comprehensive plan is a long-term guide used by local governments to shape the growth, development, and overall vision of a community. It typically addresses land use, housing, transportation, infrastructure, economic development, and environmental sustainability. In Washington, local jurisdictions planning under the state's Growth Management Act (GMA) are required to update their comprehensive plans at least every ten years (with a five year check-in interval) to reflect changing community needs, emerging trends, population shifts, and new data. Updates ensure that the plan remains relevant and effective in guiding decisions that affect the future of the community.
